Parents can now accurately track their child's weight over time, allowing our Healthy Kids staff to adjust medications, dietary plans, and make other health decisions with more accurate, consistent. and long-term data.

### **Education in Action**



**Nationwide**, Honduras saw a **445%** increase in the number of dengue cases from 2023 to 2024.

#### In FOB's partner communities...

saw a decrease in 63% dengue cases or maintained zero cases.

Dengue, a mosquito-borne disease. struck during harvest season, which is a busy time for many families. FOB staff went door to door, teaching dengue prevention, resulting in fewer cases in these communities.

## Healthy

The Healthy Honduras Program is committed to improving patient care and outcomes throughout Honduras by providing continuing education opportunities for the Honduran medical community.

Honduras has one of the highest infant mortality rates in Central America.

To help infants in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) receive the care they need, FOB taught S.T.A.B.L.E. courses through a "Train the Trainer" model.

S.T.A.B.L.E. is a leading course for training medical professionals in how to stabilize sick infants:

#### What is S.T.A.B.L.E.?

**S** ugar, **T** emperature, Airway,

**B** lood pressure,

L ab work, and

**E** motional support

"Train the Trainer" FOB trained 12 Honduran neonatal

providers as S.T.A.B.L.E. course teachers,

who then trained 77 additional medical providers in S.T.A.B.L.E. in 2024.

In total, this program has trained

over **200** medical professionals in S.T.A.B.L.E. in 3 years at 9 hospitals and clinics.





**Through a Rotary International** Grant, training "Charlie" dolls and other teaching resources were provided to the S.T.A.B.L.E. trainers.

"Train the Trainer" is a sustainable and impactful program because the education is now led by Honduran professionals year-round.




